



Did You Know?????

1. The first Beach Field Day is held on 3rd Saturday and Sunday of May at Parry's Shed with a 2pm briefing at Parry's Shed and the Weigh-in also out there at 12pm Sunday. There is a compulsory one hour lay off for a BBQ on the Saturday evening with the time determined by the field day officer.
2. It's best to reduce your tyre pressure on the tracks and the beach
3. There is a 15mtr exclusion zone to the fisher person next to you unless you're friendly
4. When the club holds an away Field Day the briefing and weigh-in is usually held at, or close to, that venue
5. The Fay Moir Shield is held each February Field Day and is for the heaviest Salmon
6. You are to bring your own firewood if you are intending to use a fire bucket and that you must adhere to the local Fire Danger Ratings at all Field Day events and at Parry's Shed
7. To take you own Unleaded 98 petrol and wood and clean up after yourself after using Parry's Shed
8. DBAC inc. has a minimum size limit of 220mm on "Other Species" of fish for the Beach Field Day and 250mm for the Boating Field Days, otherwise all Fisheries size limits are required.
9. The Trophy Donors Picnic is held at Ocean View in November and that all members are welcome. It's a great family day out.
10. You are not to cut down any trees at Parry's Shed
11. Committee meetings are held on the Thursday night before a Beach Field Day at 7:30pm at Ocean View and all members are welcome to come and see how your club is run
12. Boating Field Days are called, weather permitting, on weekends outside of Beach Field Days
13. The men's and ladies Champion Angler of the year don't always win the prize for heaviest Scale or Skin Fish
14. To keep your key to Parry's Shed you MUST be a fully financial member, and you are NOT permitted to lend, loan, borrow, or temporally give your key to others
15. A shovel nose shark is of the stingray family
16. If there are any issues with Parry's Shed please call Gavin Donohue, Parry's Beach Caretaker (0418 107 362)
17. The Beach Field Day Briefing is usually held at 1.30pm at the Slip Way on the Denmark River, near the main bridge in town, so be early to register and buy your raffle tickets
18. No fish are to be presented to the weigh-in in plastic bags, they must be on ice and in an edible condition
19. If you are not financial by July 31, you will forfeit all competition points up to the date of payment
20. That there is both a website and Facebook page for the DBAC
21. The DBAC was founded in 1924 and was for inlet fishing only
